We wish to reflect on our engagement in the "ReSPECTRUM" project, titled "cREating a Safe sPacE for inClusiviTy, sexual and ReprodUctive non-forMal education for youth workers," which took place in Pissouri, Cyprus, from June 19th to June 26th, 2023. This initiative aimed to explore sexuality, devise strategies to prevent and address bullying, enhance the role of educators, refine emotional education and soft skills, and elevate the quality of youth centers. The central objective was to develop tools for non-formal education on inclusive sexual and reproductive health for youth workers, fostering a secure environment for young individuals within local and international communities to learn about this crucial topic. Additionally, participants were encouraged to provide personal insights, enabling us to gain a glimpse into their backgrounds and objectives. This set an appropriate tone for the project's thematic focus.

The project itself was meticulously crafted, presenting a well-balanced itinerary encompassing icebreakers, group endeavors, introspective sessions, cultural engagements, reflections, and urban experiences. This well-structured schedule allowed participants to absorb new knowledge, engage in peer discussions, and internalize the content before their departure. Every participant felt embraced and confident in seeking guidance or counsel whenever necessary. Our contentment with the project's execution is evident, and we are actively pursuing dissemination initiatives at present.

In summation, our participation in this project has left us gratified and positioned us to label it a triumph. The project's intended objectives were met, and the outcomes will soon permeate local platforms through dissemination efforts. We extend our appreciation for the support and insights our organization gained along this journey.
